

Easter Story with Blanks Levels

Questions

- Read through the Easter Story PowerPoint. There are 2 versions available. The 'Easter Story PowerPoint', which is the complete version of the story and the 'Easter Story Shorter PowerPoint', which is a shorter version of the story. Repeat this task and then answer the questions at the appropriate point in the story.
- Read through the PowerPoint story and then answer the questions.
- The tables with the questions can be used to record the answers from the activity.

Blanks Level one Questions (You can read the 'Easter Story Shorter PowerPoint')

Who is that? (Point to Jesus)	Who is that? (Point to donkey)
Is this a daffodil? (point to a palm branch)	What is that? (point to cross)
What is that? (point to money)	Is this a cock? (point to donkey)

Blanks Level two Questions (You need to read the 'Easter Story PowerPoint')

Where did Jesus arrive at?	What did the important people give to Judas?
Who went to heaven?	What did they eat at the Last Supper?
Who helped Jesus carry the cross?	Where did Jesus go at the end of the story?

Blanks Level 3 Questions (You need to read the 'Easter Story PowerPoint)

How did Jesus feel when carrying the cross?	Judas betrayed Jesus. What might Jesus say to Judas?
What is a cross?	How did Peter feel when pretended that he didn't know Jesus?
When Jesus died the earth shook. How do you think the people felt?	Jesus visited his friends before going to heaven. What could Jesus have said to them?

Blanks Level 4 Questions (You need to read the 'Easter Story PowerPoint)

Why did Simon help Jesus carry the cross?	Why did the important people want to arrest Jesus?
Why did Judas take money?	Why did Pontius Pilate set Barabbas free?
Why the special dinner is called the Last Supper?	At the end of the story, why Jesus is not in the tomb?
