

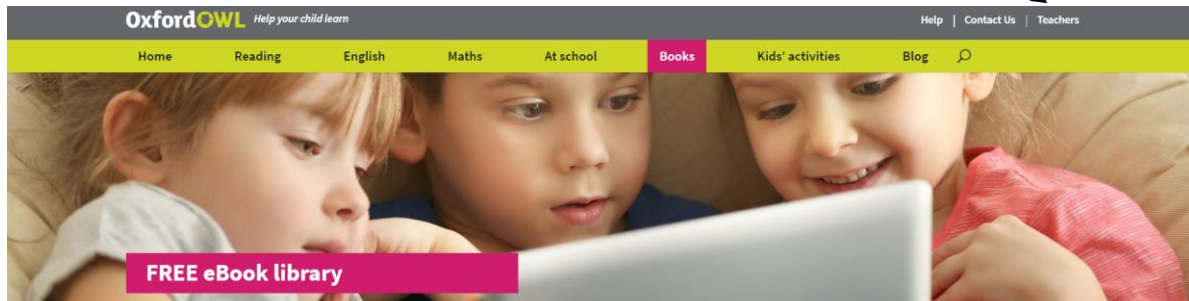
# How to access Oxford Owl for Reading at Home

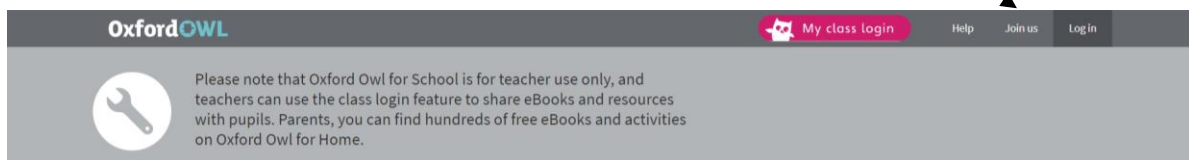
