

Round the board



A Card Game to help you to add up without using a calculator:

Compete for the highest score as you turn over the cards.

What You Need:

- ✚ Deck of cards.
- ✚ A recording sheet to add up the scores
- ✚ Aces count as 1, Jacks as 11, Queens as 12 & Kings as 13

What You Do:

1. Shuffle the cards, and deal them all face down in a circle, NO PEEPING!!!!!!
2. Each player begins by choosing one card and placing it face up in front of themselves.
3. Players write the value of this card down at the top of their recording sheet
4. When all players are ready, everyone chooses a second card. They add the value of this card to their first card and records the total on their sheet.
5. When all players are ready, everyone draws a third card, adds its value to their total and records the new score.
6. Continue until all the cards have been taken.
7. The winner is the player with the highest score.
