Round the board



A Card Game to help you to add up without using a calculator:

Compete for the highest score as you turn over the cards.

What You Need:

- Deck of cards.
- A recording sheet to add up the scores
- Aces count as 1, Jacks as 11, Queens as 12 & Kings as 13

What You Do:

- 1. Shuffled the cards, and deal them all face down in a circle, NO PEEPING!!!!!!
- 2. Each player begins by choosing one card and placing it face up in front of themselves.
- 3. Players write the value of this card down at the top of their recording sheet
- 4. When all players are ready, everyone chooses a second card. They add the value of this card to their first card and records the total on their sheet.
- 5. When all players are ready, everyone draws a third card, adds its value to their total and records the new score.
- 6. Continue until all the cards have been taken.
- 7. The winner is the player with the highest score.
