Easter themed literacy activities:

Easter story:

Read an Easter themed story with your child. Talk about the story with your child asking different questions. E.g. Who was in the story? What were they doing? (Who, what, where questions or why). Support the child to find different objects in the house to represent the story. Can they put the objects in the order of the story? Use those objects to play the story with the child.

Sensory learners: Read an Easter themed story with your child. Find different objects you can use in the house to represent the story. While reading the story to your child, show them the illustration of the book and then the fitting object. Let the child explore the different objects.

Easter scavenger hunt:

Hide different Easter related objects that you can find in the house, inside Easter eggs (optional). Hide the eggs within the house and encourage the students to find them. Encourage your child to find the hidden eggs/objects! Encourage them to sound the initial letter of the object. Sort the objects according to the letter or their colour etc.

For Readers: You can provide your child with one word hints to help them find the eggs/objects encouraging and support them to sound the letters and read the word.

Sensory learners: Let the child explore the eggs and try to open them (optional). The items hidden can be related to a story which then you can read with your child showing them the different objects while reading them the story. Let them explore the different objects and the illustrations in the book. Support the child to sort out the different objects.
