Based on the Very Hungry Caterpillar Story

Colour Recognition and Sorting Activity
 Using Duplo, Mega Bricks etc. ask the child to sort the bricks into colours. To support this activity you may choose to use the accompanying symbol colour mats.



- Using bricks count and create your own caterpillar.
- Make two or three caterpillars by simply making a tower and laying it on its side. Ask
 the child to point to the longest and shortest caterpillars. You could also try asking
 the child to put them in order of size. You may wish to try measuring the caterpillars
 using a measuring tape. You could challenge your child to find something around the
 house that is longer or shorter than their caterpillar.
- Try making a caterpillar by sequencing coloured bricks, for example green, red, green red etc. Can the child continue this sequence? As the child's confidence grows explore more complex patterns and sequences.
- Try making this caterpillar by looking at the picture.
