

Incy wincy spider activities:

- Can you copy Chloe with the signs on the video to incy wincy spider
- Make rain makers, using empty plastic bottles with rice/ lentils.
- Cotton wool clouds and finger print raindrop pictures
- Can you draw a spider? How many legs does he have? Can you count them?
- Rain cloud experiment- fill a pot/glass with water to the top, (but be careful you don't break the glass!) Use shaving foam and spray on top of the water in the glass like a cloud. Then add blue food dye for the rain (or any colour). What happens next? Can you see what is happening?
- Outdoors- Spider hunt, can you look around your garden or an outdoor space. Talk about where you may find a spider, how many you found, what colour it is and is it a big spider or a small spider?
- Spider leg games- **Game 1:** Draw a spider, write numbers 1-8 on clothes pegs (Spider legs), roll a dice and see if you can find the matching number on the spider's legs and attach the legs to your spider. **Game 2:** Use spider drawing and pipe cleaners or straws for spider legs. Roll the dice, can you say what number it has landed on, now can you add the correct number of legs to your spider? i.e. the dice lands on a 4 can you add 4

legs to your spider. Take turns with you family a great turn taking and fine motor activity.
