Hello time

Song 1 sung to the tune Frere Jacques

'Hello time, hello time,
Good looking, good looking,
Good listening, good listening, Good
sitting, good sitting'.

We will then find our name and put that at the top of our board to say who's here (you can write this on a piece of paper or card).

We will then ask what day it is and what colour is today (could explore some items of that particular colour also) and choose the correct symbols.

Song 2 is sung to 'This is the way....we brush our teeth etc.'

Monday - Red

Tuesday - Yellow

We will then take a look outside and choose what the weather is, selecting the symbol we think is most appropriate.

Finally, we will finish with how we are feeling. Children to choose a symbol that best describes how they are feeling. This is reinforced with us demonstrating the feeling (i.e. if happy, then smiling, if sad, then pulling a sad face), The song is sung to 'London bridge is falling down'
