

This week's recycling theme is music:

Glass Bottle or Jar Orchestra

You can make sounds by blowing air and tapping the glass of bottles and jars containing water.

How to do it:

1. Fill one bottle full with water and leave a second bottle empty. Use the back of the spoon to gently clink both bottles. Are the sounds different?
2. Now fill a third bottle half full with water. Clink all three bottles. How does it sound?
3. Next fill more bottles with different amounts of water but this time blow across the top. How does that sound?

Now let's get creative:

Make different sounds by blowing and tapping the containers.



Now let's experiment:

Does the sound change if you use a wooden or plastic spoon?

Does the size of the containers make a difference?

Does the colour of glass make a difference?

Does it work with plastic containers?

What tunes can you make?

Upload some of your compositions to evidence for learning.
