

## Sing a rainbow activities:

- Can you copy Claire with the signs on the video and sing along to 'sing a rainbow'.
- Using different coloured scarves or materials dance around the room making **big** rainbow shapes in the air with your arm. Throw the materials in the air watch all the colours float and fall to the ground. What colours do you see?
- If you have a colourful parachute/ just use your material can you all hold on to a side each and do big movements, going up, up, up then down, down, down. Can you shake the parachute fast or slow. Can you move the parachute around in a circle move to the left then the right? Lift the parachute up and then all quickly sit underneath it, can you see the colours?
- Using shaving foam in a tray, then put squirt of red, green, blue, yellow paints (Or whatever colours you have) you can use your hands or balls to explore the foam and mix the colours. What is happening? Are the colours changing? Are there some different colours? Can you name the colours?

You can add some paper on top of the foam and print your colour picture.

- Can you draw a rainbow and decorate it how you wish. Using coloured paper, pens, pencils or paints

- Using ice cubes holders, add paint in the trays and put in the freezer. Once frozen you can now mark make on paper and make colourful painings.
