Communication Retelling the Story of the Hungry Caterpillar

- Using the accompanying paper puppets: cut out the puppets, laminate them if you have access to a laminator and stick/attach them to lolly sticks or spoons to create puppets. Ask the child the cut them out to develop fine motor skills.
- Go out in the garden or the outside space you might have access to, with a basket to
 collect leaves, soil, sticks and stones. You can use these to create an environment to
 retell your story in. If you don't have access to outside space maybe make some
 props by painting paper to make leaves or painting pasta to make leaves, a sun,
 sticks or different types of foods.
- Consider using the accompanying 'writing with symbols.' Ask your child to collect the different foods to feed the caterpillar.
- After reading the story encourage the child to retell the story. Comment on what the
 child is doing rather than asking questions, to enable the child to have control of the
 story telling and gain greater confidence. You might end up with an alternative story,
 which is great.
