Dinosaur island sensory tray

(You could use an empty sand/ water tray)

What you need to do first:

1) Make some Kinetic

Sand Mix ½ a cup of flour with ½ cup of cornflour. Then mix in 1 tbsp of oil (add a little more oil if it is too dry)

- 2) Put the kinetic sand into your tray
- 3) Make a volcano

Use some brown paper (if you have brown), cut it into a triangle and roll it into a cone shape. Tape it into position.

Use some glue and drip it down the side of you volcano from the top and sprinkle red or orange glitter over the glue, so it looks like lava. If you haven't got glitter you could use some red material and push it in the top of your volcano.

Once your volcano is in place on the sand, you could use a battery operated tea lights (NOT a real one!) Or a small torch and put it under you volcano, to give it a glow effect.

- 4) Add some stones/ pebbles (not too small, assess for choking hazard) or if you have wooden building bricks you could use these.
- 5) Add some leaves/ sticks
- 6) Now add your dinosaurs and have fun!

(If you do not want sand you could use shredded paper.)
