


Task One - can you match the Key Stage Three adults to the picture of them when they were little? Cut out the pictures and match them. Extension - can you explain why you have matched them?






Task Three- Emily was measured when she was younger and again now that she is older. Can you work out the difference between the measurements to find out how much she has grown?
