11 = Your friend gives you 15p as a present.

12 = It's your lucky day, you win 20p.

7 = You get some pocket money, £1.10 altogether.

8 = You lend your friend £0.20.

9 = You get some sweets, they cost £0.60

10 = You drop some money, £0.30.

11 = Your friend gives you £0.50 as a present.

12 = It's your lucky day, you win £2.00.

## The Money Game (H)

If you throw:

2 = You find £1.50 behind the settee.

3 = You have a hole in your pocket, you lose £0.75.

4 = It's your birthday, you get £2.50.

5 = You buy a magazine that costs £1.20.

6 = The tooth fairy leaves you £0.50.

7 = You get some pocket money, £2.30 altogether.

8 = You lend your friend £1.20.

9 = You get some sweets, they cost £1.10

10 = You drop some money, £0.30.

11 = Your friend gives you £0.50 as a present.

12 = It's your lucky day, you win £5.00.
