

# Charades

Step One: Children can have fun looking at the pictures whilst acting out subjects such as: Cat, Car, Horse

Step Two: Once confident with this, children can act out fun things such as: Eating a banana, putting on a bandage

Remember no talking!

Differentiation: The Charades cards can also be used as tools to support communication; by asking the child "What's that?" The child can respond by making a sound associated with the subject, verbally naming it or using the Makaton sign. Or perhaps all three!

Playing charades also supports the teaching and learning of turn-taking skills.
