

Recycle magazines to create beautiful artwork.



You will need used:

- Old magazines
- An old picture frame
- Black or brown card
- Glue sticks
- Scissors.

How to make you picture:

- Take the frame apart, and use the cardboard back of the frame.
- Cut strips of colourful magazine pages.
- Fold them lengthwise
- Glue them onto the cardboard back of the frame, with the folded edges approximately 1cm apart.



Cover the whole cardboard back.

Try to use bright coloured pages for the best contrast with your dark card.



Cut your dark coloured card the same size as the back of the frame you have just covered.

Then trim an extra 3cm off of the bottom so that the finished art will show all the coloured strips along the bottom.

Either draw a pattern onto the dark card or use the patterns in the resources.

Cut out your picture, using scissors but if you use a craft knife ask a grown up to help.



When you have cut out the pattern, glue your card onto the folded magazines.

When dry, put the frame back together.
