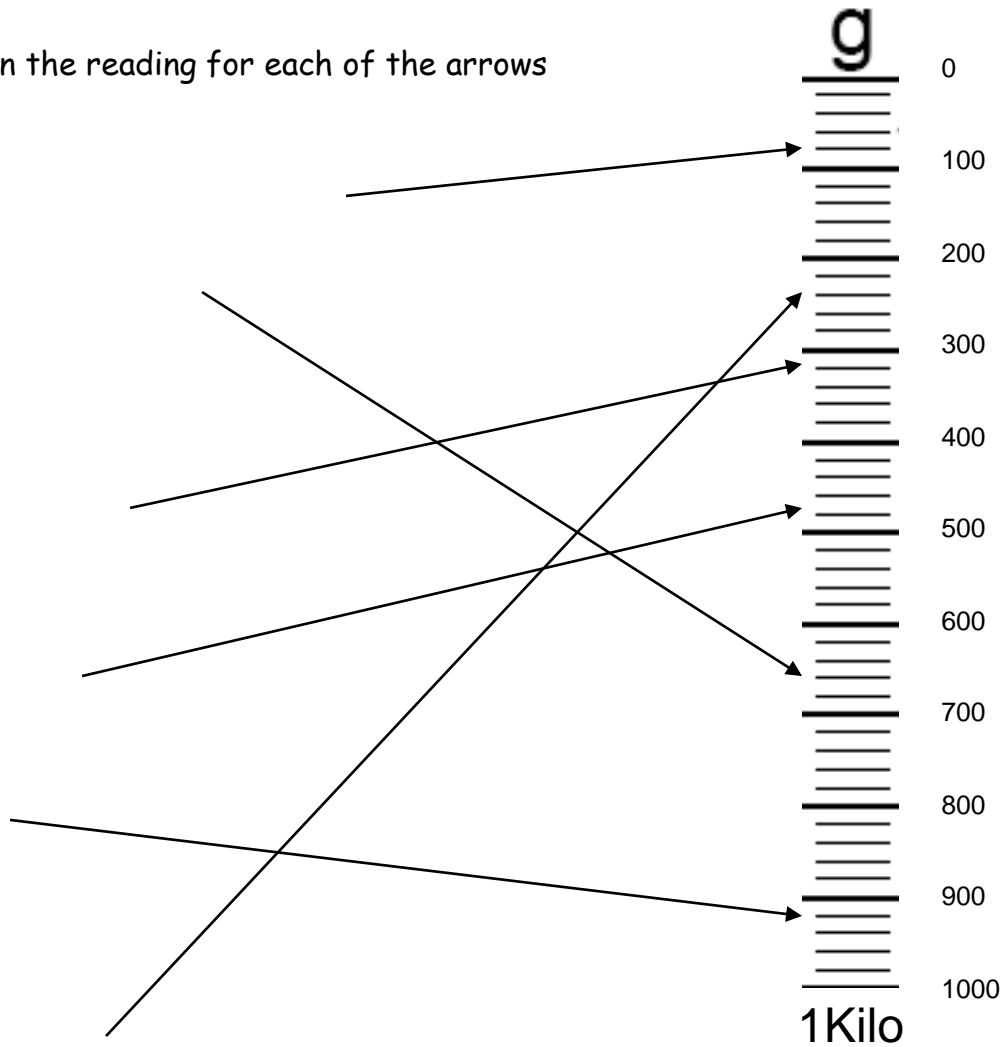


Reading Scales

1. Spring Balance

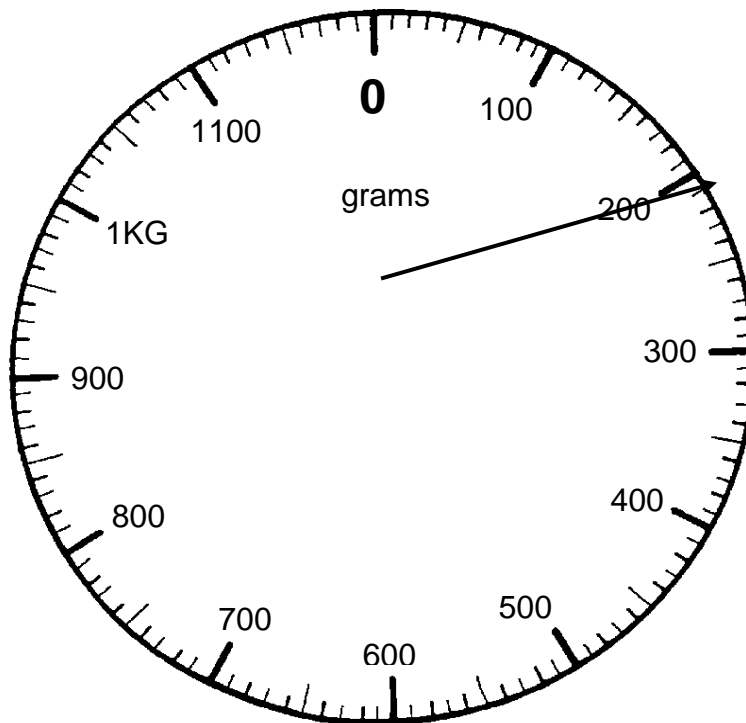
The scale shows 1 Kilogram, each big division is 100 grams, each small division is 20 grams

Weighing scales can be read like a clock, the dial indicator moves as the weight increases. Each big line is 100g, each small line is 10g. What weight does the arrow show?

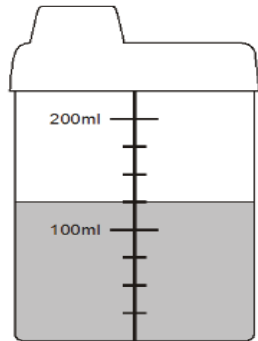


3. Use different coloured pencils and draw arrows on the scale to show these weights.

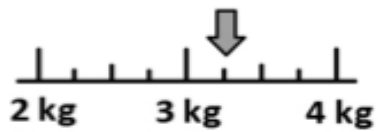
