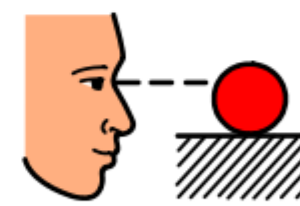
For the Butterfly:



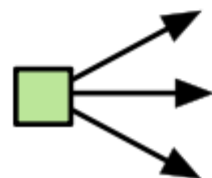
Cut out a circle of kitchen paper or coffee filter paper.



Draw circles or shapes on the paper with the felt pens.










Spray the paper gently with water. Watch the











colours spread. Wait for the paper to dry.











  Make the butterfly's body by sticking pompoms on the clothes peg or colour

 the clothes peg with  paint or  felt pens. Stick  eyes made from  paper on






the  end and if you have a  piece of pipe cleaner or  plastic bag




 tie,  wrap that  round the  end for the  feelers.

 Fold the  dried paper wings into a  fan shape. Squeeze open the

 clothes peg and  put the wings in between the  peg. You can  carefully  put

 the butterfly into it's  chrysalis and  pretend it is ready to come out.  Spread  out

 the wings and  fly your  butterfly  around!  Well done!
