

















 Shopping problems more challenging




You want to get a  treat for your  friends. You have  12  friends to buy  for. There are  packs of 4  chocolate bars and a  deal on for 3 for 2!






Each  pack  is £1.98. How much  will you  spend in  total?





Rosie  spent  £2 on  10p and  20p  stamps.. She  bought  three times as many  10p  stamps as  20p  stamps.



 ANSWERS

You need **3**  packets but as they are on **3** for **2** you only  pay for two. £1.98 **x 2 =** £3.96

Rosie bought  **4**  20p stamps and **12**  10p stamps.

11:20am. Unless your  appointment finishes  early, you will be finished  at 11:05-  too  late  to catch the  11:00  bus.

Usually,  shopping  bags  cost between  5p and  10p, so you will  save money. It will **++** mean that you  don't use as much  plastic  which is better  for the environment.
