







Laser Maze!

Have fun making a cool laser maze obstacle course in your hallway or maybe outside. **Sensory benefits:** gross motor skills, motor planning, crossing the midline, social-emotional skills

You will need:

Crepe paper roll (about 5cm wide)cut from a large roll Masking tape

You could use knitting wool but this will be harder to see so great for an extra challenge.



What to do:

Tape one end of the crepe paper roll to a door frame at one end of your hallway and then work your way down criss-crossing as you go, sticking the crepe paper to each side of the hallway to create a laser maze effect. Keep it simple to start with so there is a high chance of success to encourage your child.

Now you can take it in turns to try and creep through the maze trying not to touch the crepe paper! Maybe play some action music as a countdown:
