

Dinosaur Tuff Tray



Explore creating a dinosaur tuff tray. If you don't have a tuff tray you could use bowls, baking trays, paddling pools, a washing up bowl, bucket or just on some grass outside. If you don't have dinosaur models cut out pictures of dinosaurs and stick to kitchen roll tubes.

Explore play and positional language by commenting on play. For example; 'The dinosaur is under the hay,'

'My dinosaur is next to yours.' 'The big dinosaur is behind the small dinosaur.' Perhaps ask a few questions' 'What is your dinosaur doing?'

It is also hugely beneficial to solely comment on the child's play.

Ideas for filling Tuff Trays:

- Water, sand, mud, stones, pinecones, leaves hay, bark, sawdust
- Spaghetti or rice - perhaps dyed with food colouring, or flour
- Make your own gloop (cornflour and a little water)
- Soapy bubbles, shaving foam
