Despite it being an interesting start to the new year with lots of heavy rain and even some flooding at Bidwell Brook, it has been an absolute pleasure to meet all our new students who joined us in September and to see them all settling in over the term, getting used to new routines, new people and embracing new experiences. The weather has not dampened spirits and it has been wonderful to see our young people getting out and about participating in a range of activities including work experience and outdoor education.

Across the Federation, sessions such as swimming, climbing and tennis have restarted. At Ellen Tinkham College, our KS4 students enjoyed attending an 'Options' event recently and at Ellen Tinkham School, badminton coaching is back up and running for new groups of children. Some children are looking forward to the Forrest School Festival planned as part of the Dartmoor School's Partnership. At Bidwell Brook, Sixth Form students went to a Careers Fair at Plymouth Argyle called 'Launchpad Live' which they enjoyed. Feedback from students included: *'It was good trying a new experience.' 'I was able to manage my anxiety levels and cope in a busy environment.' 'I learnt I could do health and social care in Plymouth City College.'*

As a Federation this year, we continue to try to raise monies to enhance the educational experience we are able to provide our children and young people. We are so grateful for all the work both the BB and ET PTFA's do to help with this. They even paid for all our students to receive an Easter Treat!

Medium Sized Jars with Lids - It's a want from the Sixth Form again but this time for empty medium sized jars with lids. Before you pop them into your recycling at home, please could you give them a wash and instead, send them into us?! Thank you! **Community Fridges** - These are popping up around Devon to helping ensure that surplus food, mostly from shops and food businesses, is finding a home quickly, rather than be wasted. There are 25 community fridges in Devon, collectively redistributing an estimated 150 tonnes of surplus food, worth almost £500,000, each year.

The food in the fridges is free for people to take and it's collected primarily from businesses. It may have past its 'best before' date, but food in the fridges is before its 'use by' date. Some community fridges take contributions from households as well, such as home-grown gluts, but always check with your local community fridge volunteer as to what they can and can't take, before dropping anything off.





What Parents & Carers Need to Know about

Artificial intelligence – particularly in terms of how it generates natural language – has seen significant development over the last six months, with companies releasing new Al-based software or adding an Al element to existing apps (such as Snapchat, for example). One form of Alto become especially popular has been the 'Al friend' or chatbot, as children eagerly experiment with these new-found computer-generated companions. There are now numerous apps available with this 'virtual friend' functionality, with the likelihood of it being added to other successful platforms soon.

CONTENT AND ACCOUNTABILI

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Al chatbots may not always be able to recognise when content is age inappropriate or harmful and should be filtered out. So there's a possibility that children could be exposed to offensive language or explicit material while conversing with their virtual friend. The companies producing such AI solutions are also unlikely to take responsibility for any content that their algorithms generate.

REDUCED SOCIAL CONTACT

An excessive reliance on chatbots for social interaction could potentially cause a child to begin reducing the amount of face-to-face communication they have, leading to social isolation. If young people become dependent on chatbots to provide companionship, it could very likely hinder the development of their real-life social skills.

LACK OF SENSITIVITY

Chatbot software isn't always sophisticated enough to pick up on subtle emotional cues or recognise subtle emotional cues or recognise signs of distress in children, as most humans would. It might therefore fail to respond appropriately. Al misinterpreting what it's being told or replying insensitively to a young user who's already struggling could potentially impact a child's emotional wellbeing or exacerbate any existing emotional issues.

UNINTENTIONAL BIAS

Al companions are only as reliable as the information they've been programmed with. The algorithms they use, therefore, may unintentionally promote bias, stereotypes or discriminatory behaviour (as many originate from the USA or the UK, for instance, they can display a distinctly western-centric worldview). This could lead to children developing skewed attitudes and behaviours.

COGNITIVE **LIMITATIONS**



Although many are now undeniably advanced, Al-powered chatbots still have limitations in terms of understanding complex concepts, context and nuance. Depending heavily on chatbots to help with learning or solving problems may stunt the development of a child's own powers of critical thinking, creativity and ability to engage in open-ended discussions with other people.

PRIVACY CONCERNS

Chatbots typically collect data about users, including personal information and conversations. This is ostensibly to improve their performance as they gradually learn about our behaviour – but many experts are warning that there may be significant risks associated with how this information is stored and used (the possibility of potential breaches or misuse by third parties, for instance)

Advice for Parents & Carers

CREATE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

If your child is keen to engage with AI chatbots, encourage them to do so in a safe environment: ideally in a shared space at home, so you can easily keep an eye and ear on their progress. Set up appropriate content filtering measures in close by and ready to help with any questions or concerns that may arise.

FIND A BALANCE

Work alongside your child to establish the right balance in terms of how they might use AI-powered chatbots – and when it's appropriate. It's important to make sure that children are still getting plenty of opportunities to learn to solve problems for skills through face-to-face conversations with friends, family members and teachers.

CHAT ABOUT CHATBOTS

If your child is already expressing an interest in Al apps, a relaxed, natural chat should help you to discover which ones they're aware of and how they're using them (or are planning to). Discuss these options with your child and perhaps do your own research to ensure you think they're suitable. Once you're totally happy, you could sit with your young one and begin exploring AI chatbots together.

TAKE CONTROL

As with any form of app or game, when it comes to AI chatbots we'd strongly recommend that you consider employing parental controls (either on the device being used or within the software itself) to manage which apps your child can download and use. This is particularly important for younger children, who may be more at risk of being upset or frightened by inappropriate content.

RECOGNISE THE RISKS

It's unlikely that most children will have even considered the potential risks attached to having a virtual companion. So it's probably wise to explain some of the possible hazards and challenges of AI chatbots to your child. In particular, emphasise that AI isn't a real person (however much it might sound like one) and may occasionally tell them something that isn't entirely impartial or accurate.

EVERYDAY WALKING IN CROUCH GAIT in children with cerebral palsy

Would you like to take part in a research study?

My name is Harriet Hughes, and I am researching Crouch gait. This is one of the most common walking patterns affecting children and young people with Cerebral Palsy. It is characterized by excessive knee bend which can lead to pain and problems walking.





What do we want to find out?

We want to find out how knee muscle strength and selective motor control (the ability to move joints independently of one another), impact on crouch gait during everyday walking activities such as slopes, steps, and kerbs and compare this to children who do not have Cerebral Palsy. It is hoped that this will enable the development of new treatment approaches for children and young people with crouch gait and Cerebral Palsy.

Who can take part?


We are inviting children and young people aged 6-18 years both with and without Cerebral Palsy to take part, who can walk with or without a walking frame
