### Tuesday 26th March E-Safety Training for Secondary Families 1.30 pm in Room A at ETC, Wayside Crescent



This training aims to help you build your knowledge, skills and confidence to have everyday conversations with your young person to support them to be safer when online. The session will cover:

- What we know from research about parents and carers do well
- What helps and what hinders parents and carers from engaging with their children on this topic
- What children want and need from parents and carers
- Top tips for parents and carers when supporting their young person online

This session is designed specifically for our families with young people in our Upper School (Secondary age). It will run in person and will last 1-1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours.

There will be time for questions at the end and chances are, if you are asking something, another parent or carer will probably have the same question/thoughts as you! After the session, you can take your young person home - just inform School Transport beforehand.
