Topics

This term, our overarching theme is:

"A Wintery World"

This incorporates aspects of the weather, polar animals, hibernation and the early signs of Spring.

As we move towards the later part of the term, we will be using themes around Spring and Easter.

We will use key texts including:

- "That's Not My ..." stories
- "Polar Bear, Polar Bear"
- "10 Little Penguins"
- "5 Wiggly Tadpoles"
- "We're Going on an Egg Hunt"



The children will have opportunities to explore related textures, sounds and smells. There will be regular adult-led listening and attention sessions, Phase 1 phonics, sensory stories, art & craft as well as child-led continuous provision activities. For pupils for whom it is appropriate, there will be individual phonics interventions, hydrotherapy, rebound and physiotherapy.
