For the summer term our theme is split into two - For the first half we are using the topic How Does Your Garden Grow? and exploring minibeasts, plants, flowers and growing.

During the second half of term, we will starting thinking about summer holidays, the beach and sea.

We have key texts which we will use as starting points, currently we are using 'Superworm', and '5 Speckled Frogs'.

There will be regular adult led listening and attention sessions, Phase 1 phonics, sensory stories, art and craft as well as child led continuous provision activities.

For pupils for whom it is appropriate, there will be individual phonics interventions, hydrotherapy, Rebound and physiotherapy.

In addition, this term we will be focusing on transition and preparing the pupils for the move to Key Stage 1.

After half term particularly, we will visit the Key Stage 1 classrooms and

playground on a regular basis to allow the pupils to become familiar with the new spaces.

September class staff will make visits to Early Years to get to know the children too.
